CHARGES

- Will be those applicable from the 1st of January of the year of use of the facility rather than those applicable at the time of booking.
- Will be for the **WHOLE** of the period booked even if you vacate the Wet Dock earlier than anticipated.
- **2017 Rates are: - £32.50 per day or part of a day (Minimum Charge £65). Electricity will be charged @ 17p per unit. Diesel for heating will be charged at the current "Domestic" rate.**
- Please complete the Electricity & Diesel usage chart on the Wet Dock Notice Board.
- The hire fee will be due immediately after your use of the facility but if it is your wish you may make payment to the Honorary Treasurer at any time in advance.
- 50% of the total fee which would have been due will be required in the event of the booking being cancelled within 7 days of your start date, as it may not be possible to re-let the booked period.
- **Payment may be made into the Club's Bank Account at Barclays, Sort Code 20.81.00, Account Number 60842257, Ref-Name-W/Dock. Card payments may be made via the Club office either in person or by telephone on 01785 660725. (Not always staffed)- or by cheque.**

GENERAL CONDITIONS and INFORMATION

1. Stafford Boat Club Ltd will make every effort to ensure that the Wet Dock is available for the days you request but occasionally due to other users overrunning their time, there may be a 24 hour delay. Should this occur there will not be a charge for the period of the delay.
2. If for any reason you need to utilise the facility for a longer period than that booked, please discuss this with the Club office as soon as possible, as someone else may have booked the facility.
3. Only one boat should be in the Wet Dock at any one time.
4. A key to lock the Wet Dock may be obtained from the office upon payment of a £20 refundable deposit.
5. **Whilst undertaking your work we require that you and/or any contractor that you employ should abide by the following rules /guidelines.**
 - a) 3rd Party Indemnity Insurance for your boat of at least £2,000,000 should be in place and a photocopy of the Insurance Certificate should already be in the possession of the Club.
 - b) Paint spraying-other than for sign writing, Power or Pressure Washing and Sand or Grit Blasting are NOT ALLOWED.
 - c) NO FIRES are permitted on your boat whilst in the Wet Dock.
 - d) At all times you must keep the area around your boat safe and tidy **and at the end of your time in the facility you must remove all rubbish, paint cans etc., from the Club site and leave the area clean.** A rubbish bin is provided for use on the hard standing behind the Wet Dock. There is a skip available for METAL ITEMS.
 - e) Please take care when handling paint and oil etc., and immediately clean up any accidental spills. If any paint or other pollutant is spilled into the water it should be reported to the Harbourmaster, or the Club office, as soon as possible so that action can be taken to minimise any damage to the environment.
 - f) If welding or grinding off please use the blinds provided to protect the windows.
 - g) Similarly to when moored at the Club you must comply with the Harbourmaster's Rules, a copy of which is available to view in the winch house on site.

INDEMNITY

On using the Wet Dock at Stafford Boat Club, I (and any contractors undertaking work on my boat) accept that I will indemnify Stafford Boat Club Ltd and owners of other boats/vehicles/machinery for any loss or damage howsoever caused whilst I (or my contractor) undertake work on my boat, details of which are overleaf.

I agree to abide with all the contents of this Application and Agreement Form and confirm that the Club already holds a copy of my current 3rd Party Indemnity Insurance.
